Clothe the naked

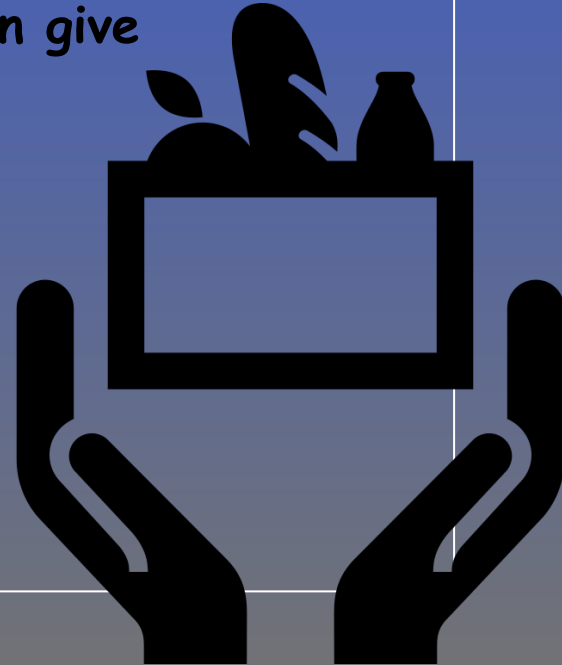
Definition: Give clothes to people who don't have any.

Examples: Donate money to homeless shelters



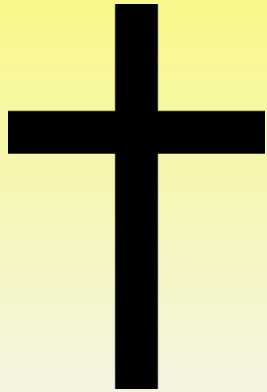
Give drink to the thirsty
